College Savings Plan Announces Big 12 Sweepstakes Winners
Edmond, OKC Residents Win Tourney Tickets, KC Hotel Stay

OKLAHOMA CITY – Kansas City here they come. Four Oklahoma college basketball fans that is. [Robert Brady](#) of Edmond and [Donna McKay](#) of Oklahoma City each won tickets to the Big 12 Basketball Championship slated for March 13-16. They'll be headed to the Sprint Center in Kansas City courtesy of the Oklahoma College Savings Plan (OCSP) which sponsored the Big 12 Basketball VIP Fan Experience Sweepstakes.

Each of the lucky fans of OCSP's VIP Fan Experience Sweepstakes won two session passes to all four days of the Big 12 Championship. They'll also enjoy three nights hotel stay in Kansas City plus an autographed basketball by the coaches Jeff Capel and/or Sean Sutton, and an OU or OSU replica jersey.

"The online sweepstakes drove thousands of college basketball fans to the OCSP website - www.ok4saving.org and that was our goal," said State Treasurer Scott Meacham chair of the OCSP board of trustees. "We wanted to build on the excitement and popularity of college basketball to raise awareness about the importance of saving for college and the tax benefits associated with the Oklahoma College Savings Plan."

McKay, a graduate of Oklahoma State University won the OSU VIP Experience and will take her husband Larry to the tournament.

"We are OSU season ticket holders and went to the Big 12 Championship about 10 years ago when it was still in Kemper Arena," said McKay. "We're very excited to spend all four days watching teams play in the new Sprint Center."

McKay says she learned of the Sweepstakes from an email blast from the State Treasurer's Office "We're just now starting to think about putting money back for our 16 grandchildren that range in age from 20 to 1 year old and the OCSP looks like one of the best ways to go about doing that."

Brady and his wife are also considering opening an Oklahoma College Savings Account for their 5 grandchildren.

All contributions and any earnings to an OCSP account are federal and Oklahoma state income tax deferred, and become permanently tax free when qualified withdrawals are made to fund an array of student expenses at most institutions of higher learning. Funds may be used at virtually any private or public college nationwide, and the savings can be applied to tuition as well as other qualified expenses including fees, books, supplies and certain room and board costs.
